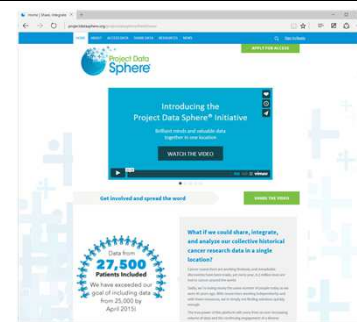

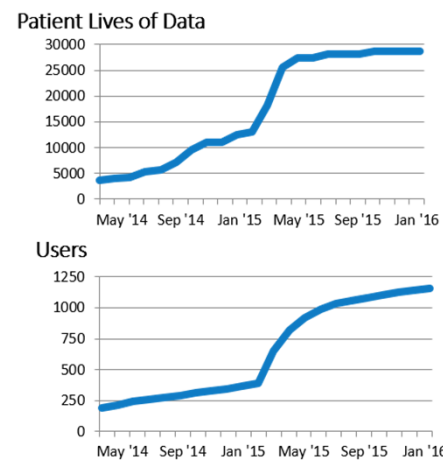
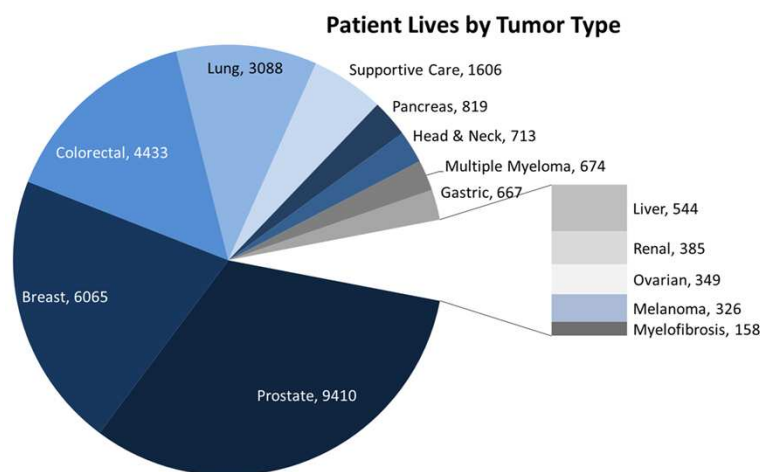
About

The *Project Data Sphere* initiative's first year brought tremendous growth in its user base and available data:

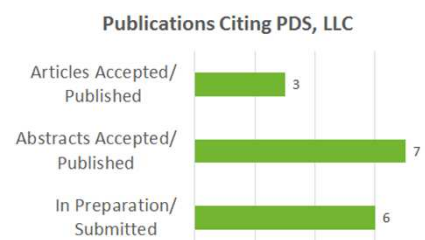

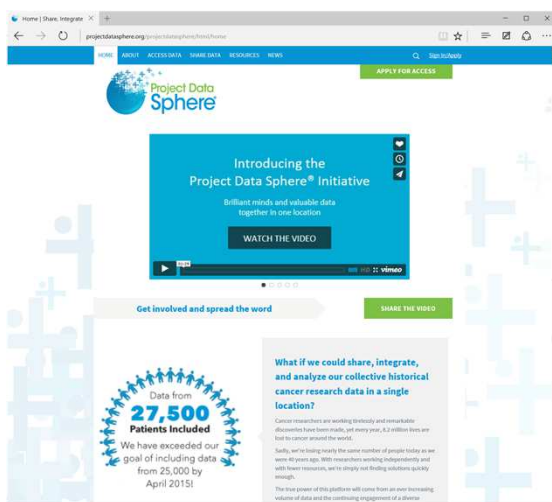

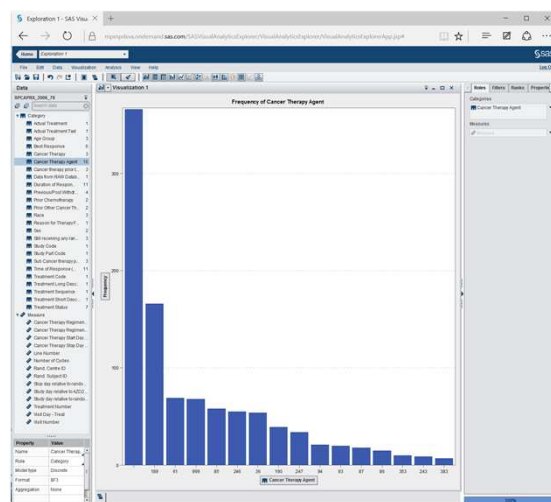
